

COACHES REQUIREMENT TO TAKE CONCUSSION COURSE

For example, AB-2007 contains a parental notification requirement: “If an athlete who is 17 years of age or younger has been removed from athletic activity due to a suspected concussion, the youth sports organization shall notify a parent or guardian of that athlete of the time and date of the injury, the symptoms observed, and any treatment provided to that athlete for the injury.” Cal. Health & Safety Code § 124235(a). Furthermore, AB-2007 requires youth sports organizations to “offer concussion and head injury education, or related educational materials, or both, to each coach and administrator of the youth sports organization,” and also obliges each coach and administrator to successfully complete this education at least once before supervising the youth sport. Id. Finally, youth sports organization must develop and identify what procedures it has adopted to guarantee compliance with the new law. Id.
